Clean Sweep is also a great opportunity for students needing community service hours for their schools.

WHAT IT IS?

A weekend event for residents to clean up debris from the safety paths and roadways that is deposited during the winter season in the community.

All trash and compost will be picked up by Green For Life Env. on the Monday following the event at each cleanup location.
