Bloomfield Township Senior Services Pool Rules and Regulations

- It is mandatory for a Lifeguard to be on duty for any pool use
- Every patron must shower and check in with the Lifeguard prior to entering pool
- Persons with skin rashes, sores, abrasions, bandages, or infections of the skin SHALL NOT use the pool*
- No Street Clothing may be worn in pool. **
- No diving, running or eating allowed
- Water shoes are strongly recommended for safety
- Bring a lock, place all belongings in a locker and secure. BTSS does not supply locks and is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Dressing and undressing is to be done ONLY in the locker rooms
- The family changing room is reserved for people needing the assistance of an aide. All others must use the male or female locker rooms
- Personal aides must stay with client at all times, including in the water
- Persons experiencing even a mild case of diarrhea may not use the pool.
- Floating aids, face masks, snorkels, etc., are at the discretion of the Lifeguard
- Long hair must be pull back and tied up at all times
- Incontinence underwear must be specifically designed for pool usage
- The pool will be closed for thunder or lightning and stay closed 30 minutes after the last lightning strike or thunder.

Prohibited in pool area:

- Gum
- Jewelry
- Band-aids or bandages of any kind
- Glass, food, all beverages but water
- Perfume or scented oils

The pool will be closed at the discretion of the BTSS management for health, weather, or for repairs. BTSS reserves the right to change the schedule when it is deemed necessary. BTSS also reserves the right to refuse admittance to or eject from the pool premises any persons failing to comply with the above rules and regulations.

During the event of inclement weather or an emergency, members are expected to comply with staff instruction. When advised, please exit the pool area in a calm and quick manner as not to disturb the water, in case of serious injury.

*A physician's letter certifying that a rash or skin lesion is not contagious and poses NO health risk to other pool users may be submitted to the Fitness Coordinator for consideration to use the pool. ([MI Pool Code](#))

**Clothing specifically designed for pool/water use may be worn if approved by Lead Lifeguard
