The public will learn about water issues ranging from aging infrastructure, water quality, stormwater to protecting inland lakes. Home infrastructure tips, Oakland County Water Commissioner infrastructure projects, employment opportunities and the Water Residential Assistance Program (WRAP) are some of the topics that Commissioner Nash will also cover. Question and answer opportunities for the public and feedback are part of these free discussions.
