This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of January 19, 2026, through January 25, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 474 calls for service, 90 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 78 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 56 Property Damage Crashes, 11 Personal Injury Crashes, 6 Hit and Run Crashes, 3 Private Property Crashes, 0 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 2 Non-UD-10 Crash.

Larceny

1751 S. Telegraph Road

On January 20. 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report of a Larceny from Detail Express, 1751 S. Telegraph Road, that occurred on January 17, 2026 at approximately 6:45 a.m. The owner of the business reported that two sets of tires (eight total) were stolen from the back of the property. The owner had the tires listed for sale. Video surveillance of the incident showed a Red Chevrolet Silverado pick-up truck enter the property and pull right near the tires. Two suspects go through a gate to the back of the property, take all eight tires, and load them into the cab of the truck. The truck is seen leaving the business approximately three minutes after arriving. This case is currently under investigation by the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations Unit. We are seeking the public's help in identifying the suspect vehicle and/or the suspects (photographs next page).
