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This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of August 10, 2026, through August 16, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 694 calls for service, 289 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 41 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 18 Property Damage Crashes, 7 Personal Injury Crashes, 14 Hit and Run Crashes, 2 Private Property Crashes, 0 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Larceny from Automobile

Retail Fraud
2400 S Telegraph Road (Target)

On August 13, 2026, at 4:51 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to a Retail Fraud in progress at Target located at 2400 S Telegraph Road. Two subjects, a white male and white female, were seen concealing items on their person. Officers arrived on scene and located the two suspects walking down the stairs past all points of purchase. The officers made contact with the suspects and discovered several pieces of stolen merchandise including a Polaroid camera, two boxes of camera film, two PlayStation video games, and two accessories for a gaming controller. Both individuals were arrested for Retail Fraud 2nd Degree. They were transported to the Bloomfield Township Police Department where they were processed and released pending court appearances.
