Weekly Media Report

August 31, 2026

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This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of August 24, 2026, through August 30, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 556 calls for service, 208 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 33 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 13 Property Damage Crashes, 8 Personal Injury Crashes, 10 Hit and Run Crashes, 1 Private Property Crash, 1 Car vs. Deer Crash, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Home Invasion

1100 block of Kemper Avenue

On August 29, 2026, a homeowner in the 1100 block of Kemper Avenue came into the Bloomfield Township Police Department to report a Home Invasion that occurred on August 28, 2026, between 12:30 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. According to the victim, a neighbor saw an unknown black male subject knocking at her front door before walking to the backyard. The victim returned home and found that a vase containing approximately \$200 in change had been stolen. According the victim, the suspect entered the home through an unlocked back door. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation. Retail Fraud

2400 S Telegraph Road (Target)

On August 28, 2026, at 9:12 p.m., Bloomfield Township Police Officers were dispatched to Target, located at 2400 S. Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. The loss prevention manager stated that they were with a suspect who had failed to scan several items in the self-checkout. Officers arrived on scene and determined that the 34-year-old female suspect out of Waterford entered Target with her three children, selected several items from the store, proceeded to the self-checkout, scanned some but not all items, placed the items in bags, and attempted to leave the store without paying for several items. Loss prevention advised that the female was known to them for doing this in the past, but it had not been reported. Approximately \$60 worth of stolen merchandise was recovered. The suspect was issued a citation for Retail Fraud and was released from the scene pending a court appearance.

On August 25, 2026, at 7:30 a.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report of a Larceny from the 1000 block of Glenwood Ct. The victim advised that she purchased a new set of Apple Headphones valued at \$549 from Apple.com. The victim received notification from FedEx that the headphones were delivered to her front porch on August 24, 2026, at approximately 4:00 p.m. The victim went to retrieve the headphones from her porch at 5:00 p.m. and discovered that the package was opened and its contents were missing. This case was assigned to the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation.
