This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. Summary:

During the timeframe of February 9, 2026, through February 15, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 539 calls for service, 206 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 37 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 22 Property Damage Crashes, 2 Personal Injury Crashes, 7 Hit and Run Crashes, 4 Private Property Crashes, 2 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Home Invasion
2900 block of Meadowood Lane

On February 10, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department responded to the 2900 block of Meadowood Lane for a possible Home Invasion. The homeowner reported that at approximately 1:40 p.m. they received an alarm for the garage service door. The homeowner canceled the alarm with the alarm company prior to police dispatch. When the homeowner arrived home at approximately 2:10 p.m., they found that the garage service door was forcibly opened. The door frame was cracked and the lock plate was located on the ground. A metal chair wedged between the door and a garage utility prevented the door from opening and no entry was made inside the home. Evidence technicians processed the scene and collected evidence. This case is currently under investigation by the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations Unit.
