This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of July 20, 2026, through July 26, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 589 calls for service, 241 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 45 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 24 Property Damage Crashes, 8 Personal Injury Crashes, 5 Hit and Run Crashes, 4 Private Property Crashes, 3 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 1 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Indecent Exposure **2400 S. Telegraph Road (Target)** **26-17424** **Arrest Made**

On July 24, 2026, at approximately 7:00 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Target, located at 2400 S. Telegraph Road, for a man masturbating while seated in his vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and quickly located the suspect, later identified as James Brian Walsh, a 59-year-old Bloomfield Township resident, inside his vehicle. During their investigation, officers observed lotion on Walsh's hands and steering wheel, as well as a container of lotion within the vehicle. Officers also determined that Walsh had recently been viewing pornography on his cell phone.

Based on the investigation, and witness statements, Walsh was arrested for Indecent Exposure and transported to the Bloomfield Township Police Department for processing.

On July 25, 2026, the Oakland County Prosecutor's Office authorized a charge of Aggravated Indecent Exposure. Walsh was arraigned by the on-duty magistrate at the 52-1 District Court and was issued a \$1,000 personal recognizance bond. He was released from custody pending future court proceedings.

**Larceny from Automobile
27000 Block of 14 Mile Road

On July 24, 2026, at approximately 5:00 a.m. the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report for Larceny from Automobile from the 27000 Block of 14 Mile Road. The reporting party stated that three suspects exited a truck that had been parked on 14 Mile Road and ran into her driveway. The suspects entered her unlocked Range Rover and stole approximately \$70 in cash from the center console. A Mercedes-Benz parked in the driveway was also checked, but nothing was stolen from that vehicle. The suspects fled the area after the theft. No additional items were reported stolen. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation. Anyone with information is urged to call Bloomfield Township at 248-433-7755.
