This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of June 29, 2026, through July 6, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 657 calls for service, 202 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 44 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 22 Property Damage Crashes, 7 Personal Injury Crashes, 5 Hit and Run Crashes, 8 Private Property Crashes, 2 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Retail Fraud
4099 Telegraph Road (Kroger)

ARREST MADE

On July 5, 2026, at approximately 8:00 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Kroger, located at 4099 Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud in progress. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect and the stolen merchandise in the adjacent gas station parking lot. The recovered merchandise included 33 different food items totaling \$307.77. Ebony Monea-Evette Haden, 35-year-old female, was placed under arrest for Retail Fraud 1st Degree. Haden was transported to the Bloomfield Township Police Department for processing where it was discovered she was already out on bond for committing a previous Retail Fraud.

The Oakland County Prosecutors Office issued a one count warrant for Retail Fraud 1st degree for Haden. On July 5, 2026, Haden was arraigned in front of Magistrate Richardson and was given a \$10,000 bond.

1962 South Telegraph Road (Aldi)

On July 2, 2026, at approximately 5:00 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Aldi, located at 1962 South Telegraph Road for a Retail Fraud in progress. Officers were advised that the suspect had pushed a shopping cart of unpaid groceries out of the front door of the store. Officers searched the area but were unable to locate the suspect or groceries. The suspect is described as a black male, medium build, wearing dark pants, white t-shirt and a tan baseball cap with a red brim. The suspect stole 5 items including Fritos, chicken breast, Tide pods and toilet paper totaling \$64.65. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation. Anyone with information is urged to call Bloomfield Township at 248-433-7755.
