*This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. ### **Summary:**

During the timeframe of February 23, 2026, through March 1, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 529 calls for service, 164 of which were traffic stops.

### **Traffic Crashes:**

Officers investigated 40 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 23 Property Damage Crashes, 2 Personal Injury Crashes, 5 Hit and Run Crashes, 9 Private Property Crashes, 0 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 1 Non-UD-10 Crash.

**Retail Fraud**  
2400 S Telegraph Road (Target)

On February 28, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department responded to Target located at 2400 S Telegraph Road for a Retail Fraud in progress. At approximately 2:00 p.m., loss prevention identified a male subject in the store that was actively concealing bottles of liquor and batteries. As officers arrived at Target, the subject, a 65-year-old black male out of Royal Oak, was coming down the elevator attempting to leave the store. A search of the suspect recovered one bottle of Maker’s Mark bourbon, two bottles of Grey Goose vodka, two bottles of Tito’s vodka, and four packages of Energizer AAA batteries. During the search officers also recovered suspected crack-cocaine. \$199.91 of merchandise was ultimately recovered. Loss Prevention advised that the suspect had been responsible for multiple other unreported Retail Frauds at the store earlier in the week totaling \$1,118.69. The suspect was arrested for Retail Fraud and Possession of a Controlled Substance. The suspect complained of chest pains and was transported to Trinity Oakland Health Hospital for evaluation. This case will be presented to the Oakland County Prosecutor’s Office for charges.

**Mail Theft**

The Bloomfield Township Police Department took multiple reports of mail tampering and mail theft during this time period. **Larceny from Automobile**  
**400 block of N Foxhills Drive**

On February 25, 2026, at approximately 7:30 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department responded to a Larceny from Automobile that just occurred in the 400 block of N Foxhills Drive. The victim stated he had returned home from the grocery store and was carrying his groceries into his residence when he observed his vehicle's rear driver side door ajar and an unknown male near his vehicle. The suspect took off running south in the parking lot when he saw the victim. The suspect stole multiple items including a grocery bag of food, and a backpack containing an iPad, a laptop, text books, and various notebooks. Officers scoured the area and a Bloomfield Township K9 attempted a track of the suspect. Officers were unable to locate the suspect. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Investigation's Unit and is currently under review. **Larceny from Automobile**  
**400 block of S Foxhills Drive**

On February 24, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report of a Larceny from Automobile in the 400 block of S Foxhills. The victim stated that within the last two weeks his catalytic converter was stolen off of his Ford Fusion. The exhaust pipe showed two fresh cut marks where the converter would typically be located. The oxygen sensor wire was hanging beneath the vehicle. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Investigation's Unit and is currently under review.
