This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of March 16, 2026, through March 22, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 574 calls for service, 165 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 41 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 29 Property Damage Crashes, 1 Personal Injury Crash, 3 Hit and Run Crashes, 7 Private Property Crashes, 1 Car vs. Deer Crash, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Retail Fraud
3600 W Maple Road (Kroger)

On March 18, 2026, at approximately 2:20 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Kroger, located at 3600 W Maple Road. Officers were investigating a reckless driver and improper parking complaint when they discovered a cart full of stolen alcohol outside the store. Four 24-packs of Modelo Especial, four 12-packs of Tito's mini shooters, and five bottles of Titos Handmade Vodka were recovered and confirmed stolen from the store less than an hour prior. Officers reviewed video surveillance from inside the store and determined the driver they were speaking with for improper parking was the suspect in the Retail Fraud. The suspect, a 57-year-old black male from Southfield, was subsequently arrested for Retail Fraud and transported back to the Bloomfield Township Police Department where he was processed and released pending charges.
