This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. Summary:

During the timeframe of March 2, 2026, through March 8, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 590 calls for service, 179 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 30 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 22 Property Damage Crashes, 2 Personal Injury Crashes, 1 Hit and Run Crash, 4 Private Property Crashes, 1 Car vs. Deer Crash, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Home Invasion
5000 block of Windingwood Drive

On March 8, 2026, at approximately 3:30 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to the 5000 block of Windingwood Drive for a Home Invasion that occurred while the homeowners were out of town. Officers arrived on scene and determined that the homeowners had been out of town since the beginning of March. When the homeowners returned home they found the side window to the home pried open and the jewelry box missing. It appeared that other belongings in the residence were rummaged through as well. Evidence Technicians processed the residence and this case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations Unit. Retail Fraud
2105 S Telegraph Road (Dick's Sporting Goods)

On March 6, 2026, at approximately 9:20 a.m., Bloomfield Township Officers responded to 2105 S Telegraph Road, Dick's Sporting Goods, for a Retail Fraud. Employees stated that a black male wearing dark clothing left the store without paying for merchandise and drove away. According to the cashier the male inquired about applying for a store credit card and began to fill out an application. The cashier asked to see the suspects identification when he reached over the counter, grabbed the bags of merchandise, and left the store without paying. The male, described as a black male approximately 20 to 30 years old with scruffy beard, stole multiple Nike clothing items totaling \$429.99.
