This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of April 27, 2026, through May 3, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 594 calls for service, 296 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 44 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 29 Property Damage Crashes, 2 Personal Injury Crashes, 6 Hit and Run Crashes, 6 Private Property Crashes, 1 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Assault and Battery
200 Block of Glenhurst Drive
ARREST MADE

On May 2, 2026, at approximately 4:30 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to the 200 Block of Glenhurst Drive for an ASSAULT and BATTERY that just occurred. The victim, a landscaper, reported that he was trying to cut the lawn at a client's home when he discovered a different landscapers' tools left on the lawn, and in his way. The victim could not locate the other landscaper and moved their tools off of the lawn, and onto the walk way.

A short time later, the other landscaper returned and got into an argument with the victim. After the victim and suspect verbally argued for a short time the suspect grabbed the victim and wrestled him to the ground. The suspect punched the victim while on the ground. Eventually the two separated and while the victim was calling the police, the suspect fled the scene in a grey/silver Buick sedan.

On May 3, 2026, officers located the suspect driving a grey Buick sedan, in the same area that the crime took place. They attempted to make a traffic stop on the Buick but the vehicle quickly parked and the driver walked away from the vehicle on foot. The suspect was located a short time later, hiding inside of Kroger, where he was arrested for ASSAULT and BATTERY.

On May 4, 2026, the Oakland County Prosecutors Office authorized a one-count warrant for Misdemeanor ASSAULT and BATTERY against the suspect. He will be arraigned later on today, May 4, 2026, at the 48th District Court.

Retail Fraud 1st Degree
2400 S Telegraph Road
ARREST MADE

On May 2, 2026, at approximately 9:00 a.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to 2400 S Telegraph Road, Target, for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. It was reported that a male suspect was inside an elevator with unpurchased merchandise including luggage, wine and several Lego sets. Officers waited by the elevator doors and stopped the suspect, matching the description given, as he exited the elevator. The suspect had a shopping cart full of luggage, wine and several Lego sets. The suspect, identified as JESSE LOVE 28-year-old black male, was placed under arrest for RETAIL FRAUD 1st DEGREE. The stolen items were valued at \$1437.94.

On May 3, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department Investigations Unit received a one-count felony RETAIL FRAUD 1st DEGREE warrant for LOVE. LOVE was arraigned in front of Judge Bosnic from 52-1 District Court and was given a \$25,000, 10% bond. LOVE has two future court dates on May 11 and May 18, 2026.

Retail Fraud 3rd Degree
2139 S Telegraph Road
ARREST MADE

On April 29, 2026, at approximately 4:00 p.m. the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to 2139 S Telegraph Road, T.J. Maxx, for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. Upon arrival, T.J. Maxx Loss Prevention had one female in custody for stealing multiple baby items. Loss Prevention stated they saw the female suspect walk down the baby aisle of the store, select items, and conceal them in her purse. The suspect passed all points of sale without purchasing the items. The stolen items totaled \$28.96. The female was cited for Retail Fraud 3rd Degree, trespassed from T.J. Maxx., and released from the scene.
